Organizational Regulations for the Special Education Implementation Committee

- Article 1 The National Taiwan University (NTU or “the University”) Special Education Implementation Committee (“the Committee”) is established in accordance with Article 45 of the *Special Education Act* to better meet the needs of special education students by integrating and consolidating available resources, planning special education teaching strategies, improving accessible educational software and hardware, and promoting special education efforts at the University.
- Article 2 The Committee is responsible for the following tasks related to student counseling and learning support:
1. Review of the University’s special education strategies and annual work plans for students with disabilities
 2. Approval and review of the University’s special education budget and its apportionment
 3. Promotion and planning of an accessible learning environment
 4. Coordination of administrative tasks across administrative units, colleges, and academic programs; consolidation of special education resources from within and outside of the University
 5. Coordinating with academic programs to provide admission through screening and test to students with disabilities
 6. Other special education-related tasks
- Article 3 An Executive Vice President of the University shall serve as the chair of the Committee. The remaining seats shall be filled by the Vice President for Academic Affairs, Vice President for Student Affairs, Vice President for General Affairs, and Vice President for International Affairs; the Head of NTU Library; the Director of the Accounting Office; the dean of each college; directors of the Student Safety Center, Student Housing Service Division, Student Assistance Division, Health Center, and Student Counseling Center; and two special education students at the University (each with a different type of disability).
- Article 4 Members of the Committee shall be appointed by the President at the start of the fall semester each academic year and shall serve a one-year term without compensation.
- Article 5 In the event that the chair of the Committee is unable to host a meeting, a member shall be appointed to act on the chair’s behalf.
- Article 6 The Committee shall convene once per semester. Extraordinary meetings may

be called as necessary.

Article 7 The Committee may only convene with more than half of its members present, and a resolution is only effective with more than half of the attending members in concurrence.

Article 8 The Regulations shall be passed by the Administrative Meeting and then implemented on the date of promulgation.
